







SUBJECT: FIAMMETTA'S lost books

To: Maj. N. MAUGHAN-BROWN.

- 1. After being finally liquidated, FIANMETTA put in a claim for compensation for some engineering books she had left in the care of Capt. BUTI, an Italian Officer employed by VIGILANT for recruiting and taking care of agents.
- 2. On 29th Jun 45; I visited the building which was used as holding house by VIGILANT in Autumn 43. I found it now being used as a Mess by an American unit.
- 5. The Mess Sgt assured me there were no Italian Engineering books in the house. He was very definite on the point, adding that had there been any books, he could not have failed finding them in the course of his duties.
- 4. The Sgt. also informed me that there had been at least two other American units in occupation of the house before his own unit took over, and suggested that they might have disposed of the books.
- 5. I then tried to find out the present whereabouts of Capt. BUTI, in whose care the books had been left, but the neighbours were unable to give me any information on the subject.
- 6. In the circumstances, I think that the books in question should be considered as irretrievably lost.

In occasione delle celebrazioni per la festa della Liberazione del 25 aprile, come si legge nella lettera al Corriere della Sera, il Presidente del Consiglio Giorgia Meloni ha dedicato la giornata a Paola Del Din. La Premier l'ha definita "donna straordinaria, madre idealmente di tutti gli italiani che antepongono l'amore per la propria Patria a ogni contrapposizione ideologica". Paola Del Din, oggi quasi centenaria, che ha combattuto durante la Resistenza con il nome di battaglia "Renata", ha ricevuto la Medaglia d'oro al valor militare ed è considerata "la prima donna paracadutista militare italiana".

La verità è un'altra, non fu lei la prima donna paracadutista italiana, per i fatti e per la storia.

La prima donna paracadutista militare italiana fu la nostra Maria Ciofalo, nata a S.Stefano di Camastra il 4 marzo del 1913 figlia di Ciofalo Giovanni e Sortino Giovanna, coniugata con Caracciolo Angelo (il matrimonio si tenne il 10 dicembre del 1955 ad Acireale).

Maria Ciofalo in Caracciolo, alias "Fiammetta - Stella", studentessa di Ingegneria a Napoli dove prese parte alle 4 Giornate, dopo aver completato un ciclo di corsi di istruzione per agenti segreti presso il SOE di Monopoli (Ba) arrivò in Veneto. Il 17 luglio '44, a Montagnola di Grantorto (Pd), assieme ai sabotatori delle Missioni Alleate "EGI 3" e "EGI 4", fu paracadutata come agente del SOE (Special Operations Executive). Ciò è riportato in "I grandi rastrellamenti nazi-fascisti dell'estate-autunno del 1944 nel Vicentino. Le Operazioni "Belvedere" - "Timpano"- "Hannover" - "Piave", redatto nel 2019, in occasione del 75esimo anniversario della Liberazione, dal Centro Studi Storici "Giovanni Anapoli e Francesco Urbani Pat" Montecchio Precalcino (Vi) - www.studistoricianapoli it, Associato all'Istituto Storico della Resistenza e dell'Età Contemporanea della provincia di Vicenza "Ettore Gallo. Ed è ancora riportato nel libro "É cessata la pioggia". Guerra segreta nella provincia di Rovigo, nel Veneto meridionale 1943-1945, Edizioni "La Lucertola" - Badia Polesine, 2018. L'autore Claudio Vallarini cita Maria Ciofalo "prima donna paracadutista italiana".

Per quanto in premessa, i sottoscritti Consiglieri Comunali, già in contatto con la famiglia della Ciofalo e da tempo impegnati nella ricerca di fonti storico-militari, comunicano l'intenzione di pianificare, per la primavera del 2024 un evento per scoprire, conoscere e far conoscere Maria Ciofalo. Riteniamo giusto affidare il suo valore ed il suo ricordo alla memoria della nostra Comunità e restituire alla Nazione ed alla storia la verità di una donna coraggiosa, ribelle e prima paracadutista italiana.

Perché ciò si realizzi, si chiede, previa condivisione dell'iniziativa, la sinergia e la collaborazione dell'Amministrazione e del Consiglio Comunale, anche per convenire sulla eventuale disponibilità di risorse economiche da destinare all'organizzazione dell'evento suddetto.
